- Existing Trees
Do not remove, provide information on age and root extent or to provide or enhance root support
 - Fruit & Nut Trees
Do not remove, maintain as required, protect at spacing of 4.0m over a series of years, monitor, prune, etc.
 - Native & Ornamental Trees
Planted as larger specimens for immediate impact
 - Native Flowering Hedgerow Mix
To provide visual screening and habitat
 - Community Gardening Space
A defined, enclosed space for vegetable growing
 - Meadow Grass
Medium mowing regime, unless indicated, allowed with appropriate mowing cut. Seed costs seeds which require. Paths can be down to provide alternative routes through the field
 - Overspill car park
Grass seeding through outdoor reinforcement system for extra car parking provision
 - Native hedging mix
planted barrier & shrub row staggered for quicker establishment
 - Resin Bound Gravel
A surface providing durability and accessibility for all
 - Permeable parking surface
gravel filled outdoor system or gravel
 - Bulb Planting
forms an essential part of planting to provide spring interest under deciduous trees
 - Block Paving
Contrasting permeable surface for crossings
 - Timber Bleacher Seating
Placing over the structure with the vegetation
